Katalina Huerta Latinos in Technology Scholar, Class of 2018

Katalina Huerta is a second-generation Latina born and raised in San Jose, CA. Katalina is the first on her mother's side to graduate from college with her bachelors degree in health science from Whitworth University in 2020. As an essential worker, she is passionate about health science and has her sights set on graduate school with the ultimate goal of becoming a Physician Assistant in the near future. In her spare time, Katalina enjoys exercising.

Alexander Vazquez Latinos in Technology Scholar, Class of 2020

Alexander Vazquez is first-generation Latino born in Livermore, CA where he was raised alongside his parents and siblings. Alexander began his academic journey at Las Positas College and later transferred to San Jose State University, where he most recently obtained his bachelor's degree in chemical engineering. He is now a graduate student conducting research on polymer chemistry.





Maria Serratos Parent Education Academy Graduate

Maria Serratos is from a town called Amacueca in Jalisco, Mexico, and is a proud mother of 3 children. Her two oldest are students at UC Irvine and San Jose State University, and her youngest is a freshman in high school. Maria is a graduate of the Hispanic Foundation of Silicon Valley's parent education academies. Maria is very involved in her children's education and is always looking for new opportunities to learn skills. One of Maria's takeaways from this year is that it is never too late to learn new things. A program to grow the high-tech workforce by preparing Latino students with strong STEM (science, technology, engineering, and math) skills and supporting their transition to and through college.

LATINOS IN TECHNOLOGY SCHOLARSHIP



This program awards scholarships of up to \$10,000 per year for up to three years to Latino juniors and seniors who have declared a major in a STEM (science, technology, engineering, and math) related field at a 4-year university.

We also pipeline our scholars into summer internship programs and provide career coaching opportunities.

COLLEGE SUCCESS CENTER

We successfully completed a full year of online learning programs with increased attendance and retention rates. We had 109 parents graduate from our newest program, *Digital Literacy for Parents, Aprendizaje Digital*, and established a partnership with McKinley Elementary School as a new host site for our youth STEM classes and parent education programs.
