Requirements:

- Minority students, particularly African- American; American (North, Central, or South) derived from Spanish speaking cultures; Native American; and Pacific Islanders.
- Be enrolled for the fall semester prior to the award (or have completed your course work within the past year) at Diablo Valley, Contra Costa, or Los Medanos Colleges. Applicants may not be currently enrolled nor intend to enroll before next June in a four-year college or university.
- Be eligible (have sufficient and proper units) to transfer to a four-year institution with junior standing for the next fall term (or at the latest the next spring term) following the award.
- Provide evidence of financial need.
- Complete and submit on time the application with all required attachments.

Scholarships For Minority Students

McDonald's HACER® National Scholarship

Deadline: January 2024 Award: Tier 1 (\$100,000), Tier 2 (\$20,000), Tier 3 (\$10,000)

Requirements:

- You have at least one parent of Hispanic/Latino heritage.
- You're a high school senior
- Must be a legal U.S. Resident, U.S. Citizen or a DREAMER/DACA recipient
- You're under 21 years old
- You carry a minimum 2.8 GPA
- You're eligible to attend a two- or four-year college, university or vocational/technical school with a full-time course of study
- You'll disclose other scholarship programs that you've applied for
- You'll enroll and attend an accredited institution in the academic year after your selection (verification needed, as scholarship funds are paid directly to the schools)



Scholarships For Undocumented Students

TheDream.US National Scholarship

Deadline: February 29, 2024 Award: Up to \$33,000

Requirements:

- You are undocumented and came to the United States before November 1, 2018, and have continuously lived in the United States since then or have DACA or TPS
- Came to the United States before the age of 16 (if you were born in the U.S. you are not eligible for our scholarship)
- Have significant unmet financial need
- Have graduated or will graduate from a United States high school (or have earned or will earn a high school equivalency diploma) before the Fall of 2024
- Graduated or will graduate with a high school GPA of 2.5 or better on a 4.0 scale or have a cumulative college GPA of 2.5 or better
- Intend to enroll full-time in an associate or bachelor's degree program at a Partner College in your state in the Fall of 2024 or Spring of 2025
- Are eligible for in-state tuition at the Partner College you want to attend (not applicable if it is a private Partner College in your state)

Que Llueva Café Scholarship

Deadline: February 10, 2024 Award: Up to \$1,000

Requirements:

- Must be an undocumented student (DACA students are eligible).
- Must be or will be a high school/GED graduate who will enroll for the first time in an accredited college or university in the U.S. or Puerto Rico for the 2024-2025 academic year. Due to limited funds, current college students are not eligible.
- Exception: Those students who have not completed high school/GED program and are dual enrolled in a college are eligible.







Scholarships For First Generation College Students

Hispanic Education Endowment Fund

Deadline: Varies Award: Varies from \$1,500 - \$5,000

Requirements:

- Latinx resident who has lived in Orange County (O.C.), California for the past three years.
- An O.C. high school graduate or an O.C. community college transfer student who plans to enroll full-time at a four-year college or university in the upcoming fall semester.
- First-generation college student.
- Demonstrate financial need through a completed FAFSA application or California Dream Act Application.

- Proof of academic excellence, such as high standardized test scores, GPA, AP courses.
- Some scholarships are specifically designed for students with financial need. Applicants may need to submit financial aid forms and provide documentation of their income.
- Applicants must demonstrate involvement in extracurricular activities, volunteer work, or leadership roles in their community.
- Explain why the applicant is deserving of the scholarship.
- Require letters of recommendation from teachers, mentors, or other professionals who can attest to the applicant's character, academic abilities, and potential.

- Only low-income students will be considered for this scholarship program (typical family income does not exceed \$60,000, although special circumstances can create exceptions to this guideline)
- Graduating HS Senior OR Community College UC Transfer: must have graduated from one of the high schools targeted by Pursuit of Excellence (check website)
- Students must graduate from highschool in good standing planning to attend a 4-year university or a community college and then transfer to a 4-year institution
- For community college transfer applicants: students must apply to transfer to a UC and be eligible to transfer the year they apply for POE
- Preference is given to students who have worked during their high school years
